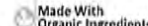
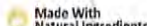

What is Math 24? In 1988, inventor Robert Sun created the first edition of the 24 GAME, Single Digits, to help train young minds in the processes and patterns of mathematics. Sun's revolutionary approach alleviates a classic brand of math anxiety—getting the right answer—and instead puts emphasis on the method behind the math. Without fear, children naturally take action, explore, think mathematically, learn, grow and build a love for math that lasts a lifetime.

Currently, students in grades 1-6 have been given on-line licenses to Math 24 from Senator Lisa Boscola. Mrs. Okula is forming two Teams: Team 1: Grades 4/5; Team 2: Grades 6-7-8
