Student Renewals (Re-Enrollment): For the 2024-2025 school year, current students will automatically be renewed for enrollment. The non-refundable registration fee of \$75 will be automatically withdrawn after you go to the Family Portal and update your re-enrollment packet. Please complete by March 15, 2024. If your student is not returning, please notify Mrs. Okula by April 1, 2024 in writing.

New Families: To Enroll at St. Jane School: Please apply online at www.stjaneschool.com. To begin the application process, click APPLY. Upon account creation, you will receive an email containing a verification link. Once your email address has been verified, log in to your account and Create a New Student Application for your child. You will then have the flexibility to log in and out of your account and access your application and complete the enrollment process. A non-refundable fee of \$125 must be submitted with each application.

FACTS Tuition Management Program: There are three methods for making tuition payments: (1): Full payment on or before July 5, 2024. This payment may be made through our FACTS Tuition Management system or payment at school in cash or check payable to St Jane School. (2): 10-month payment plan with FACTS; (3) Semi-annual payments with FACTS. Payments begin in August and end in May. Payments through FACTS incurs a one-time service fee

Gift Certificate Obligation – St. Jane Dollar\$ are a wonderful way for you to help your school earn funds! It is a NO-Cost to you fundraiser. St. Jane Frances de Chantal Parish buys gift cards from many area and national stores and restaurants at discounted prices and sells them to our parishioners/school families at face value. This generates a profit that translates into income for our Parish to use toward our Parish subsidy. Every family is required to purchase \$4,125 in gift cards or you may opt out by paying \$215. Please note: 2% of the gift cards purchased over and above the \$4,125 quota will be deducted from your child's 2025-2026 tuition bill.

Financial Aid: You can apply for financial aid ONLY through our Simple Tuition Solutions and is intended for situations of financial difficulty. There is an application fee per family for situations where siblings attend separate Catholic schools. Financial Aid is NOT guaranteed and the request will be evaluated based on need and available funds. Aid granted to ACTIVE Parishioners will receive funds from the Parish. Non-members or non-tithing parishioners may need to wait for funds from other sources, which are not always guaranteed. All tuition and other fees must be paid in a timely manner. The child(ren) may be disenrolled if there is an outstanding tuition or other fee at the end of each trimester or the end of the school year. Report cards and other documents will be held until the financial obligations are met. Students may not be able to participate in school events, such as field trips and graduation, if fees/tuition is owed.
